1. How do intensive needs students get certified?

Attached please find the *Intensive Review Worksheet*, which outlines the requirements for identification of students with intensive needs.

4 AAC 52.700(c) governs the Intensive Process:

- Reviewed by three special education certified, department staff for compliance with the regulatory criteria
- Detailed administrative review of all finalized claims
- District status notification in mid-January
- Districts have 30 days to resubmit (or provide additional supporting information)
- After 30 days, department determinations are issued
- Districts may appeal the department's decision to the Commissioner's office under 4 AAC 52.750
- After the appealing to the Commissioner's office, districts may also request a formal hearing

2. How often do they get evaluated (once they are identified, do they stay on the list forever)?

Due to the nature of the intensive requirements, most students do not leave the intensive count, but there are many that no longer qualify for funding. School districts are required and expected to exit those students. As an example, Mat-Su School District has a positive track record of exiting students when they no longer qualify.

Training for district Special Education Directors is conducted twice a year. This is not a "how to" training, but rather focuses on ethics and a depiction of what the regulation is looking for. Typically, only the larger school districts show evidence of exiting students (usually due to increased independence). DEED currently only reviews new claims.


As a minimum, DEED believes there is a strong need to go back and check ECDD (Early Childhood Developmental Delays), SLD (Specific Learning Disabilities) and SI (Speech Impaired). DEED has a team of three staff that reviews intensive claims, and the work occurs during the middle of the federal special education compliance monitoring and reporting requirements. The three DEED staff members review approximately 650-725 new intensive claims each year. For FY2020, there were a total of 716 new intensive claims, of which 656 are currently approved and 60 were denied.

3. Please explain the 32% increase as it relates to the formula for calculating BSA for intensive needs students.

Intensive funding is intended for students who need and receive intensive services for special education (4 AAC 52.700). Funding is in addition to other special needs funding (federal and State grants, etc.). Funding is currently 13x the base student allocation (BSA). Approximately

650-725 new students are claimed annually. Specific regulatory requirements (4 AAC 52.700) must be met by all claimed students.

Below please find a graph illustrating intensive claims over time and the percent of intensives compared to the total average daily membership (ADM), starting in 2007.



4. Are we out of compliance with Kasayulie (because of the veto of 50% of the REAA School Construction Fund)?

No. According to the Department of Law, a proportional reduction to both the REAA and Small Municipal School District School Fund and the School Debt Reimbursement program does not violate Kasayulie.

5. Please explain the situation with the Kilbuck school fire insurance issue (does the insurance cover the replacement and if not was this by regulation or statute?).

There has been lots of dispute between the parties on levels of coverage, amount of damage, etc. The district was required to carry replacement cost insurance and they did, but the insurance companies are disputing what that coverage provides. DEED is in first position on the lease of the land and building(s) from the City, but we assigned that lease to LKSD around 2010, and they have been the primary agent in the insurance negotiations. Regulation (4 AAC 31.200(e)) only prescribes directly involving the department in all insurance settlement processes if we own the building. The Kilbuck building is owned by the City of Bethel, not DEED. DEED Facilities staff are reaching out to LKSD leadership for an update.

6. Museums fee increase: Is there any way to make it so only out-of-state residents get charged the additional \$2 to access the state museums, not residents?

Currently, the state museums do not gather statistics on visitors' residences.

State museums currently offer the following discounted rates:

- 1) Annual passes for \$35 (proposed to increase to \$40) that allow for unlimited admission to both museums.
- 2) Youth under the age of 19 are admitted free.
- 3) Discounted admission is implemented during the winter season.

Lastly, the \$2 increased fee is anticipated to cover the operating and maintenance costs associated with the museums. Limiting the fee increase to non-residents only will reduce revenue projections, and may result in the museum needing to implement additional fee increases in the near future.

7. Is anyone tracking whether or not boarding school students who may turn 18 while in school, have the proper ID to travel home?

DEED reached out to two residential schools who shared the following information:

- Mt. Edgecumbe High School: Staff track each student to ensure they have original documents necessary to verify residency and assist in the application process for obtaining a state identification.
- Bering Strait - Northwestern Alaska Career and Technical Center (NACTEC): Staff heavily encourage all students to bring three original documents from home to verify residency, especially for when they participate in driver's education. Students may apply for either a driver's license or other state identification. The staff also contact principals at the student's prior school to express the importance for students to bring original documents when they arrive. If necessary, staff will assist students in obtaining official documentation, such as a birth certificate. This applies to all students who are 16, 17, or 18 years old.

8. Is there a reason not to have Parents as Teachers in DEED as a program in SB 6?

DEED and DHSS are committed to continuing collaborative efforts to support the Parents as Teachers program wherever it resides.

The Alaska Reads Act is designed around quality. There are standards of quality that must be applied in the pre-k, reading intervention, and school improvement sections of the bill. Integrating the Parent as Teachers program with the other elements of the bill will increase the likelihood of success for students.

9. What are your projections for Pre-K enrollment and how are they calculated?

The cohort of students every year is about 10,000 per grade. DEED looked at the number of students participating in preschool programs within Alaska and then tried to determine how many additional students could be served if we wanted to strive for an approximately 88 percent participate rate. Through this process, an estimated total of 3,675 students were identified that would be served annually by this legislation.

10. Do you have a matrix on how the BSA would be tracked for pre-K (1/2 ADM? Because we have not tracked preschool before?)

Pre-K students will be tracked in the same manner as every other student within Alaska.

The State Board of Education and Early Development adopted a regulation in 2001 that required DEED to assign no later than August 31, 2002, an individual student identification number for each student in the state. To accomplish this, DEED has implemented a high security, password

protected, web-based system that assigns these numbers. School districts use this number when they report electronic student information to DEED, including test scores.

The number is unique to each student and is not a Social Security Number. The number enables DEED to better analyze student information and make informed policy decisions. Additionally, the number allows for more accurate reports of school and student performance to the governor, legislature, and public.

The student identification number is for department use only and becomes part of a student's school record. The number does not change if a student moves from one Alaska district to another. Beyond its use by DEED for data analysis purposes, the student identification number has no other purpose or significance.

The Alaska Student ID System can only be accessed by school district personnel who have been assigned usernames and passwords.

11. If the BSA for pre-K is increased, how does it affect the BSA for other groups (e.g.: special ed, intensive needs, others?)

The Base Student Allocation (BSA) is the same for all students. Per AS 14.17.470, the BSA is \$5,930. There are various factors within the foundation formula, such as the Special Needs (AS 14.17.420(a)(1)) and Vocational & Technical (CTE) (AS 14.17.420(a)(3)) that get applied to the entire student population.

The Intensive Services factor is based on a head count. The 13x multiplier (AS 14.17.420(a)(2)) only goes to those special education students who need and are receiving intensive services (they must meet intensive qualifications), and are enrolled on the last day of the 20-day count period.

12. Will there be a "gap" in the pre-K grant funding - effective date of SB 6 vs. existing grant funding time frame.

A limited number of districts may experience a gap in pre-k grant funding during the transition. Of the ten district grantees who received the \$6M 2-year (FY2019-2020) pre-kindergarten grant funds from DEED that expire at the end of FY2020, seven of those districts are recipients of DEED's Comprehensive Literacy State Development (CLSD) grant (funding over 5 years starting in FY2020). The three districts who may not receive State or federal pre-k grant funds in FY2021 can consider utilizing other funding sources, such as fund balances, federal Title dollars, dividend raffle funds, and other local funding sources to continue their pre-k programs during the interim transition period.

Further, districts who meet the high-quality early education program standards established through SB 6 can apply for approval of their program, passing over the grant funding, and if approved, can receive foundation funding for their students. Timing of the passage of the Alaska Reads Act will impact DEED's ability to implement the legislation so districts can access the pre-k grants and foundation funding for approved early education programs in the 2020-2021 school year.

13. Rankings question – lowest performing school districts – can you provide a copy of the list (SB 6)?

14. Please explain the 10% (increase?) for instructional oversight (SB 6).

In Section 14.30.770 (page 20, line 9) of CSSSSB 6(EDC), DEED would like to increase the school eligibility pool from "the lowest performing 10 percent of schools" to the "lowest performing 25 percent of schools."

The school improvement portion of the Alaska Reads Act is a voluntary, opt-in program. Expanding the number of schools that qualify increases the likelihood of successful partnerships. DEED and the expanded list of qualifying schools can consider factors such as need, school size, infrastructure, leadership capacity, readiness, and staff-community interest.

Attached please find the spreadsheet of potential school eligibility pools by percentage under this section of the bill.

15. Did DEED oversight improve Yupiit rankings?

DEED's past approach to its oversight of Yupiit was done under the authority of the No Child Left Behind Act. The Yupiit School District did not have the option to reject DEED's oversight resources. Since that time, and after DEED's oversight ended, the Yupiit School District has received approximately \$2,385,406 additional dollars for school improvement.

Yupiit School District remains one of the lowest performing districts in the state. The bill language in the Alaska Reads Act directs DEED to take a distinctly different approach to school improvement. Specifically, the intensive reading intervention services is a voluntary program. DEED will approach its relationship with schools who choose to apply and are selected to participate through a partnership model, where services are informed by and with the people they are intended to serve.



4 AAC 52.790

(20) "basic adaptive skills" means, beginning in the school year that commences July 1, 2010, rudimentary facility, as appropriate to the age of the student, in

- (A) communication;
- (B) social or emotional development;
- (C) motor development;
- (D) cognitive functioning;
- (E) behavior; and
- (F) daily living or self help skills;

(23) "appropriate to the age of the student" means with consideration of the wide range of ages during which children develop skills, particularly children under six years of age for whom a basic skill may be developing or emerging;

(24) "individual care" means providing for the health, safety and individual needs of the student with personal attention by a certified special education teacher, a special education aide, or another trained person; for purposes of this paragraph "personal attention" means

- (A) full-time one on one attention
- (B) attention provided on other than one on one basis if
 - (i) one on one care is not required for a particular intensive student;
 - (ii) the district has provided the level of care necessary to protect the health and safety of the child; and
 - (iii) the teacher, aide, or other trained person attends to no more than three intensive students at a time.

(25) "rudimentary facility" means, beginning July 1, 2011,

- (A) scoring two standard deviations below the mean on a standardized adaptive measure approved by the department; or
