

SB 209 Sectional ver. K

Section 1: Requires the Division of Motor Vehicles to mail state IDs to Department of Corrections facilities under the bill.

Section 2: Requires the DMV to mail a driver's license renewed by mail to Department of Corrections facilities. This section does not require the DMV to issue new drivers licenses under the bill.

Section 3: Requires the Commissioner of Corrections to work with the Commissioner of Administration to make a good faith effort to ensure prisoners serving longer than 120 days in prison have a state ID in hand when they are released.

Section 4: Removes language that required the Department of Corrections to teach prisoners how to get a state ID before their release.
