## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA  
2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

This legislation amends AS 12.63 establishing a mechanism to allow an offender's information to be removed from the Internet registry.

AS 12.63.035 (a) (2) establishes a condition for removal from the internet registry that requires the sex offender or child kidnapper, within the previous year, be assessed as low-risk by a treatment provider approved by the Department of Corrections under AS 44.28.020 (d), at the offenders expense.

AS 12.63.035 (g) establishes a process that allows the court to require the Department of Corrections pay all or a portion of the required assessment costs if the court determines an offender is indigent.

AS 44.28.020 is amended adding a new subsection (d) that requires the Department of Corrections (DOC) to adopt standards, through regulation, of psychosexual evaluations and risk assessments for sex offenders and child kidnappers and approve mental health providers administering the psychosexual evaluations and risk assessments that meet the DOC developed standards.

The department is not able to determine costs associated with the number of offenders that the Court would deem indigent and have the department pay a portion or the full amount of the assessment; therefore, an indeterminate fiscal note is being submitted. The Department will monitor for any future financial impacts if this legislation is passed.
