## **A RESOLUTION**

1 Commemorating the Anti-Discrimination Act of 1945.

# 2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 3 WHEREAS Alaska Natives faced systemic discrimination and were denied basic civil
- 4 rights during the state's territorial days; and
- 5 WHEREAS Elizabeth Peratrovich, Grand President of the Alaska Native Sisterhood,
- 6 and her husband, Roy Peratrovich, Grand President of the Alaska Native Brotherhood,
- 7 successfully petitioned the Alaska Territorial Legislature and the governor to enact the Anti-
- 8 Discrimination Act of 1945; and
- 9 WHEREAS the Anti-Discrimination Act of 1945 banned discriminatory signage and
- made it a crime to discriminate based on race in public establishments; and
- 11 WHEREAS this landmark legislation was the first anti-discrimination law in the
- 12 United States; and
- WHEREAS February 16, 2020, marked the 75th anniversary of the Anti-
- Discrimination Act of 1945 being signed into law;
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature recognizes the historical
- importance of the Anti-Discrimination Act of 1945 as the vanguard of anti-discrimination

- legislation in the United States; and be it
- FURTHER RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature commemorates the 75th anniversary of the Anti-Discrimination Act of 1945.
