### FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

## STATE OF ALASKA 2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

# **Analysis**

AS 18.65.676 would require Village Public Safety Officers to attend the training academy for a longer duration. AS 18.65.670(b) is amended to allow for the increase in the number of grantees possible for the program, which may create a larger than usual VPSO class size going through the academy for the required training laid out in AS 18.65.676. The increase in possible cadidates and the increase in duration will create an increase in costs for the academy in the areas of travel for instructors and meals, lodging, and supplies for the candidates.
Current costs for the VPSO to attend the training academy is \$7,370 per student. HB 287 would increase the VPSO training requirements and the costs of the academy would increase to \$8,500 per student. The fiscal note is indeterminent at this time, as DPS is not able to predict how many more VPSOs will be hired under the expanded number of eligible grant applicants. There is an anticipated increase in hiring and in academy attendance.

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
