FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to liability of an electric utility for contact between vegetation and the utility's facilities; and relating to vegetation management plans."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 09.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 09.65.086. Civil liability of electric utility for contact between vegetation and utility facilities. (a) Except as provided in (b) of this section, a utility offering electrical service to the public for compensation under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by the former Alaska Public Utilities Commission or the Regulatory Commission of Alaska under AS 42.05.221 may not be held liable for property damage, death, or personal injury resulting from contact between vegetation and the utility's facilities.

(b) This section does not preclude civil liability for property damage, death, or personal injury resulting from contact between vegetation and the utility's facilities if

(1) the vegetation was located entirely within the boundaries of the
