## HB 190 Explanation of Changes — Ver. A to Ver. S

## Section 1 AS 43.23.005(a)(4)

Changes the time an individual must be physically present in the state over a two-year period from 72 consecutive hours to 7 consecutive days.

## Section 3 AS 43.23.005(a)(8)

Reduces the number of allowable absence days for settling an estate from 220 to 120.

### Section 3 AS 43.23.008(a)(17)

Allows participation in a marmite registered apprenticeship program to qualify as an allowable absence under AS 43.23.008.

### Section 3 AS 43.23.008(a)(18)(A)

Reduces the total number of days an individual may be out of state, in addition to the allowable absences under (a)(1)-(18), over the course of a year from 180 to 120

### Section 4 AS 43.23.008(d)

Reduces the number of allowable absence days in each of the five preceding qualifying years from 180 to 120.

### Section 4 AS 43.23.008(d)(1)

Increases the number of days an individual is required to be physically present in the state during the past five years from 30 cumulative days to 90 cumulative days.
