Senate Bill 55 Version S

"An Act relating to judges of the court of appeals; and providing for an effective date."

Senate Bill 55 provides a solution to the backlog of cases at the Court of Appeals. Since 2014, more criminal appeals are being filed than are being decided. This has led to a mounting caseload that is increasingly difficult to resolve. The Court of Appeals is currently composed of three judges. These judges work diligently and maintain a heavy workload, but unheard cases just keep accumulating. A long delay before criminal appeals are decided is not acceptable for crime victims, the general public, attorneys, or defendants.

Senate Bill 55 enables the Court of Appeals to hear cases in a timely manner. This legislation would add a permanent fourth judge to the court of appeals to address the backlog and allow the court to keep pace with the caseload in the future.
