23 (c) A beverage dispensary licensee with a beverage dispensary repackaging

1 endorsement

2 (1) may repackage alcoholic beverages for sale on the licensed  
3 premises for consumption off the licensed premises by opening the original package  
4 for the purpose of subdividing the contents into smaller packages.

5 (2) is authorized to sell, each day to a person on the licensed premises  
6 for consumption off the licensed premises, not more than 5.167 gallons of beer;

7 (3) may permit an agent or employee to repackage alcoholic  
8 beverages, but may not permit a customer or another person who is not an agent or  
9 employee of the licensee to repackage alcoholic beverages

10 (4) is authorized to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption off the  
11 licensed premises during the time allowable under local ordinance.

12 (d) The holder of a beverage dispensary license who repackages alcoholic  
13 beverages without an endorsement under this section commits the offense of  
14 unendorsed beverage dispensary repackaging.

15 (e) The holder of a beverage dispensary repackaging endorsement who fails to  
16 comply with the requirements of this section commits the offense of beverage  
17 dispensary repackaging endorsement noncompliance.

18 (f) Unendorsed beverage dispensary repackaging is a violation and is  
19 punishable by a fine of \$500.

20 (g) Beverage dispensary repackaging endorsement noncompliance is a  
21 violation."
