Sectional Analysis HB 128 Version A

Section 1: This section amends AS 5.15.060(a), which instructs the Department of Revenue to develop and adopt regulations to carry out Chapter 15, to establish standards for online ticket sales that will ensure compliance with charitable gaming laws with specificity to location and age requirements; data security to prevent sale to someone whose age and location have not been verified; and other concerns the Department feels is necessary to protect the public interest.

Section 2: This section amends AS 05.15.640 to add new subsections, (d) and (e), to allow permittee, operators, or holders of a multi-beneficiary permit to use the Internet or Internet communications to conduct charitable gaming activities such as raffles, lotteries, dog mushers' contest, derby, or other classic defined in AS 05.15.690 (definitions). The permittee will be allowed to conduct the event, and draw the winning ticket, online. It also stipulates that the permittee, operator, or holder of a permit will at the time of the sale, verify the person's legal purchasing age, physical presence in the State of Alaska, and is not in an area that has adopted a local option prohibiting such gaming.
