#### Alaska's Motor Fuel Tax Statutes & Regulations

### AS 43.40.005 - AS 43.40.100

"Motor fuel" is defined by statute as any fuel used in an engine for the propulsion of a motor vehicle or aircraft, fuel used in or on watercraft for any purpose, or in a stationary engine, machine or mechanical contrivance which is run by an internal combustion motor.

15 AAC 40.300 - 15 AAC 40.900

These are regulations that interpret the Motor Fuel Tax statutes



#### **Brief History of Alaska's Motor Fuel Tax**

- 1945 First motor fuel tax levied at \$0.01/gallon
- 1970 Motor fuel tax was increased to \$0.08/gallon
- 1977 Marine fuel tax was increased to \$0.05/gallon
- 1994 Aviation fuel tax was increased to \$0.047/gallon
- Sept. 1, 2008 Aug. 31, 2009 Motor fuel tax suspended across all fuel types
- 2015 HB 158 added a \$0.0095/gallon surcharge on motor fuel
- 2019 SB 115 proposed to increase highway fuel, gasohol, and marine fuel rates, but the bill did not pass both bodies.



#### **Current Motor Fuel Tax Rates & Surcharge**

Highway Fuel – \$0.08/gallon

Marine Fuel - \$0.05/gallon

Aviation Fuel - \$0.047/gallon

Jet Fuel - \$0.032/gallon

Gasohol – \$0.08/gallon or \$0.02/gallon depending on the season, location, and U.S. EPA mandates

Surcharge - \$0.0095/gallon

#### **Motor Fuel Tax Returns & Tax Payments**

- Returns are filed and tax is paid monthly
- Online filing is required
- Four Separate Returns:
  - 1. Gasoline
  - 2. Diesel
  - 3. Aviation
  - 4. Gasohol
- Taxpayers who file and pay on time can receive a credit of 1% of the tax and surcharge due (limited to a maximum credit of \$100 per return).




