#### **FY2022 Significant Budget Changes**

- Add 112 new beds at Parkview CRC
- Additional electronic tracking and monitoring at CRC's
- CRC and EM structure change



## COMMUNITY RESIDENTIAL CENTER SUMMARY

FY2016 transfer \$1,514.8 from PCC closure to increase CRC beds by 50 beds. Decrease contracts (\$601.2).

FY2017 VETO (\$1,500.0) to reduce contracts.

Transfer (\$714.5) to Correctional Academy.

Added \$500.0 SB91 Fiscal Note


FY2018 decrement (\$8,059.2) unused beds.

Added \$500.0 SB91 2nd year Fiscal Note

FY2020 added one-time funding of \$3,992.4

FY2021 reverses the one-time funding (\$3,992.4). Includes one-time CARES funding \$5.033.6.

FY2022 adds \$3,975.0 for Parkview 112 beds

## **ELECTRONIC MONITORING SUMMARY**


EM is funded via UGF and DGF from collected fees.

FY2020 includes onetime funding of \$1,241.0 UGF for 100 additional EM placements.

FY2021 reverses the one-time funding (\$1,241.0) UGF Adds one-time CARES funding \$220.2

FY2022 adds \$461.5 for CRC GPS monitoring program.




#### **FY2021 RECRUITMENT RESULTS**
