Analysis

The legislation would have zero impact on University of Alaska (UA) operations.

The legislation is related to the Alaska savings program for eligible individuals; related to the education savings programs; related to the Education Trust of Alaska; related to the Alaska advance college tuition savings fund; relating to the Alaska education savings program for children; and related to the Governor's Council on Disabilities and Special Education.

According to the legislation, an education savings plan for eligible children shall be maintained under As 14.40.802-14.40.817 and the state shall continue to encourage investment for the education for those children. UA encourages investment, but foresees a zero fiscal note at this time.
