FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2021 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill would add and amend statutes under the Alaska Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission establishing new statistical areas in the eastern side of Cook Inlet, encompassing the Kenai and Kasilof Rivers, for set gillnet permit holders, and a buy-back program resulting in subsequent, permanent, checkerboard closed waters.
Department of Public Safety, Division of Alaska Wildlife Troopers has several enforcement programs in the same area at the same time the closures would occur. DPS AWT is not able to determine if there will be additional enforcement impacts and whether existing resources will be adequate to respond to and investigate complaints arising from the changes. Therefore, DPS AWT submits an indeterminate fiscal note.
