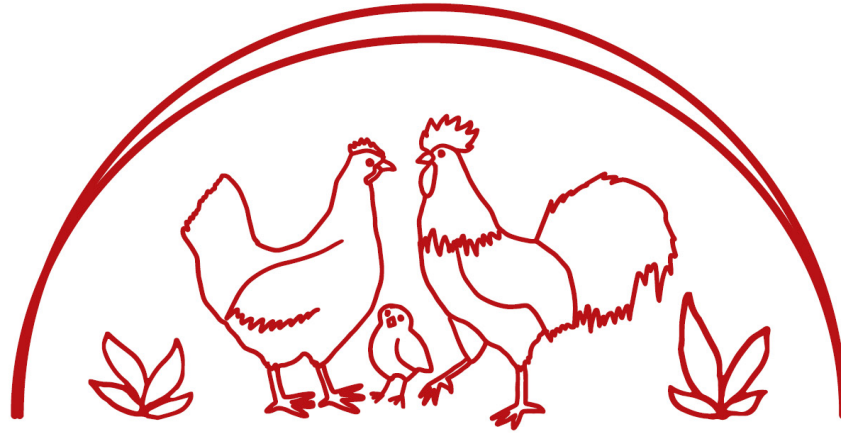

a lot of space to grow food in AK!

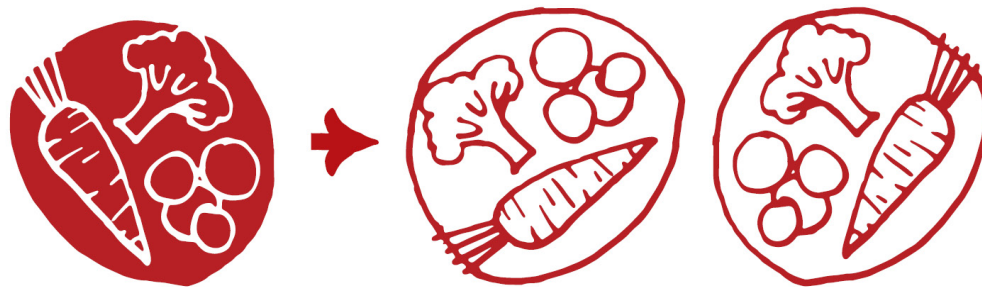
