




### Alaska wage and salary employment by month, 2018-2021




## Employment by economic region, over-the-year percent change, 2018-2021




### Employment for Alaska and U.S., over-theyear percent change, 2018-2021




### Alaska wages by quarter, 2019-2020




## But, wage losses were more than offset by big increases in government "transfer receipts"




### Alaska's long-term population history
