Analysis

The bill amends AS 14.35 adding Article 2, Concurrent Vocational Education, Training, and On-the-Job Trade Experience Programs. Under the new Article, AS 14.35.125 lists the requirements for instructor certification for the new programs which includes the requirement for instructors to submit fingerprints and fees to the board. The board is required to submit the fingerprints and fees to the Department of Public Safety for a criminal history record check under AS 12.62.160 and AS 12.62.400.

The bill amends AS 12.62.400(a) adding a new subsection (21) authorizing the Department of Public Safety to obtain a national criminal history record check for an instructor certificate under AS 14.35.125.

The requirement for the national criminal history background check under AS 12.62.400(a)(21) is new for the Department of Public Safety, and the volume of submissions for instructor certificates is unknown at this time. It is believed at this time, the number of submissions can be absorbed with current resources and therefore a zero fiscal note is submitted.
