The purpose of this letter is to provide you with clarification to statements made during the April 9 hearing for HB 90. We heard testimony that the Department of Revenue supports HB 90. There was also a quote from the slide deck on page 6 which is a statement that was made in June of 2018 by a former tax employee in regard to litigation with a peer to peer vehicle rental company.

Please be advised that this Administration has taken no position on HB 90 at this time.

The Department will continue to administer and enforce the vehicle rental tax consistent with current statute and guidance from the Department of Law.
