Dear Representative Hopkins:

I respectfully request that House Bill 160 be scheduled for consideration in the House Transportation Committee at your earliest convenience.

HB 160 would modify procurement statutes to codify the CMGC (Construction Manager/General Contractor) procurement process. This innovative two-step procurement process selects a qualified construction contractor to actively participate in the preconstruction phase and provides that contractor an opportunity to also perform the construction phase of that same project. CMGC can save project costs and avoid time delays by increasing collaboration, reducing and sharing risk, improving design quality and schedule optimization, benefitting from the contractors experience and involvement from project design through to completion.
