Definition of a Victim

Sponsor Statement

SB122 is a bill that removes the word “adult” before the word “child” in the definition in AS 12.55.185 (C ii). By removing the word adult, the definition of a victim will include a child of a person who has been a victim of a crime when a parent or guardian is deceased. SB122 will ensure victim rights for a child of a deceased parent or guardian.
