- 1 "An Act requiring state participation in a tribal child welfare compact."
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- * **Section 1.** AS 47.05 is amended by adding a new section to article 1 to read:
- Sec. 47.05.110. Alaska Tribal Child Welfare Compact. The state shall participate in a tribal child welfare compact with Alaska tribes and tribal organizations for the administration of child welfare services by the tribes or tribal organizations. The compact is a written agreement between the state and Alaska tribes and tribal organizations that affirms the government-to-government relationship between the state and tribes.
