SECTION 3. SCOPE OF WORK & CONTRACT INFORMATION

SEC. 3.01 SUMMARY

The Department of Administration, Division of Shared Services, Statewide Contracting (SSoA), on behalf of the Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS), is soliciting proposals for a subject matter expert to serve as a DHSS Senior Advisor and Strategist to the Commissioner of DHSS for a 12-month period, starting approximately August 2019, not to exceed 850 hours.
