This bill extends the sunset date for existing funding allocations for program and grant distributions under AS 23.15.835(d) for the Alaska Technical and Vocational Education Program (TVEP) through June 30, 2024. Funding authorization for the Workforce Development component was included in the FY2022 Governor Amended request. In FY2023, the administrative service provided by Workforce Development will be phased out and no further funding allocation will be required for FY2023 or FY2024.
