Analysis

The proposed legislation allows an Alaskan to request to be registered as a voter through their Permanent Fund Dividend (PFD) application. This will require the PFD Division to modify online and paper application forms. Based on the eligibility definition in AS 43.23.005, the PFD Division will send information to the Division of Elections that eligible applicants provided in their PFD applications. Eligibility is an ongoing activity; the PFD Division will transmit monthly voter registration information as an applicant becomes eligible. The proposed legislation will also require the PFD Division to notify the Lt. Governor of a security breach.
The PFD Division estimates one-time programming costs of 139 hours at \$120 per hour for a total of \$16.7. There are no ongoing costs associated with this proposed legislation.
