Dear Senator Olson:

Thank you for your recent introduction of SB 113. All six Western Alaska Community Development Quota (CDQ) program organizations stand united in support of reinstating the CDQ Resource Landing Tax Credit Program (RLTC). The CDQ program represents 65 western Alaska communities and utilizes fisheries resources to provide benefits to our region, alleviating poverty and working toward sustainable local economies.

As you know, the CDQ RLTC expired December 31, 2020. SB 184 was introduced during the 31st Legislature to extend the CDQ RLTC through 2030. However, it did not ultimately pass despite wide support, largely due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Passing SB 113 this session will allow CDQ harvest partners to again redirect approximately 45% of their landing tax liability from CDQ harvest back to the CDQ program for fisheries related investments and research. In 2019, the Department of Revenue and Legislative Finance Division recommended continuation of the CDQ RLTC and estimated no foregone revenue by the State.

In recent years, the CDQ RLTC has specifically allowed for increased investments from the CDQ program to ensure stability in western Alaska community development priorities and collaborative fisheries research efforts in support of the State. In order to continue our fisheries related investment and research activities, including work in support of the State, we urge swift passage of SB 113 to renew the CDQ RLTC. All six CDQ groups stand prepared to assist your office and the entire CDQ legislative delegation in this effort.

The support of the State of Alaska and the Alaska State Legislature since the inception of the CDQ program in 1992 has been instrumental to our many successes. We hope to continue this fruitful partnership long into the future.


