BUDGET ACTION:

The Senate Finance Budget Subcommittee staff for the Legislature's budget met with Legislative Affairs and Legislative Budget and Audit staff and the subcommittee analyzed all of the Legislature's budget transactions. Following are budget highlights.

Amended Budget Request:

 Accepted the Legislature's amended budget request, with one exception, detailed later.

FY22 Senate Finance Legislature Sub-Committee Close-Out Narrative / April 28, 2021

Sub-Committee Additions, Reductions and Changes:

- Denied a request of \$1,395.2 thousand for Legislative Audit to conduct agency performance reviews.
- Added \$1 million Unrestricted General Funds to the Redistricting Board for operating and legal defense costs.
- Added \$1 million of Unrestricted General Funds to Legislative Audit for costs associated with the annual statewide single audit.
