FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to justification of use of force by a peace officer; and relating to
- 2 shooting at a moving vehicle."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 11.81.370 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- firearm at or in the direction of a propelled vehicle while another person is operating the vehicle, the use of force is not justified under this section unless the person is operating the vehicle in a manner that poses an immediate threat of serious risk to the life of the officer or another person.
- * Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:
- 12 APPLICABILITY. AS 11.81.370(d), enacted by sec. 1 of this Act, applies to conduct 13 by a peace officer occurring on or after the effective date of this Act.
