A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to the definition of 'victim.'"**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 12.55.185(19) is amended to read:

4 (19) "victim" means

5 (A) a person against whom an offense has been perpetrated;

6 (B) one of the following, not the perpetrator, if the person
7 specified in (A) of this paragraph is a minor, incompetent, or incapacitated:

8 (i) an individual living in a spousal relationship with the
9 person specified in (A) of this paragraph; or

10 (ii) a parent, adult child, guardian, or custodian of the
11 person;

12 (C) one of the following, not the perpetrator, if the person
13 specified in (A) of this paragraph is dead:

14 (i) a person living in a spousal relationship with the
15 deceased before the deceased died;

- 1 (ii) a [AN ADULT] child, parent, brother, sister,
2 grandparent, or grandchild of the deceased; or
3 (iii) any other interested person, as may be designated
4 by a person having authority in law to do so.
