FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2021 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

HB 91 removes the requirement for Alaska-licensed veterinarians to register with the state's controlled substance prescription database, commonly referred to as the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP). It also removes the requirement for veterinarians to review the animal's owner/caregivers prescription history and report controlled substances prescribed to the animal. Optional access by veterinarians would be permitted.
The Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing anticipates there will be an estimated \$7.0-\$10.0 in lost revenue for the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program per biennium as a result of this legislation. Regulations changes will be required but the costs are minimal and can be rolled into another regulations project.
Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by receipt supported services, fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF). Licensing fees for each program are set per AS 08.01.065 so the revenue collected approximately equals the occupation's actual regulatory costs.
