3 **\*\* Section 1.** AS 08.01.063(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) Except as provided in (d) of this section, and notwithstanding another  
5 provision of law, the department or appropriate board may issue a temporary courtesy  
6 license to the spouse of an active duty member of the armed forces of the United  
7 States if the spouse applies to the department or appropriate board in the manner  
8 prescribed by the department or appropriate board. An application must include  
9 evidence satisfactory to the department or appropriate board that the applicant

10 (1) is married to and living with a member of the armed forces of the  
11 United States who is on active duty and assigned to a duty station in this state under  
12 official active duty military orders;

13 (2) holds a current license or certificate in another state, district, or  
14 territory of the United States with requirements that the department or appropriate  
15 board determines are substantially equivalent to those established under this title for  
16 that occupation;

17 (3) if required by the department or appropriate board for obtaining a  
18 license in the applicant's profession, has been fingerprinted and has provided the fees  
19 required by the Department of Public Safety under AS 12.62.160 for criminal justice  
20 information and a national criminal history record check; the fingerprints and fees  
21 shall be forwarded to the Department of Public Safety to obtain a report of criminal  
22 justice information under AS 12.62 and a national criminal history record check under  
23 AS 12.62.400;

1                   (4) has not committed an act in any jurisdiction that would have  
2 constituted grounds for the refusal, suspension, or revocation of a license or certificate  
3 to practice that occupation under this title at the time the act was committed;

4                   (5) has not been disciplined by a licensing or credentialing entity in  
5 another jurisdiction and is not the subject of an unresolved complaint, review  
6 procedure, or disciplinary proceeding conducted by a licensing or credentialing entity  
7 in another jurisdiction; and

8                   (6) pays any fees required under this title."
