									Chevak School Fire Remediation On Sunday, March 7, 2021, the old, unused school building in the community of Chevak caught fire, and the structure was destroyed. During the subsequent investigation it was identified that two community members were unaccounted for, and believed to be under the structure during the fire. During the initial site investigation by Department of Public Safety (DPS), the site conditions including the roof structure on top of the debris made the search field unsafe for DPS investigators to continue the search for the two individuals without logistical support.
