HOUSE BILL 22

"An Act relating to shared animal ownership; and relating to the sharing and sale of raw milk and raw milk products."

SECTIONAL ANALYSIS

(Revised 1.20.21)

Section One

Adds a new section, **Section 17.20.015**, to AS 17.20 (the Alaska Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act) to allow for raw milk (presently allowed by regulation¹) and raw milk products (new) produced from the milk of shared ownership, and by an owner, to be directly shared with other owners.

In addition, Section 17.20.015 prohibits the Department of Environmental Conservation from adding restrictions and additional requirements on the sharing or transfer of raw milk between owners of a milk-producing animal.

Section 17.20.015 also defines raw milk as not pasteurized milk and raw milk product as a product or byproduct of raw milk.

¹ The provisions of 18 AAC 32.010 - 18 AAC 32.060 do not apply to a person who owns a cow, goat, or sheep and uses the milk from the animal for that person's personal use.
