DECORATION OF HONOR MEDALLION

- HB 244 (2007) created the Decoration of Honor
 - “The Joint Armed Services Committee shall make arrangements for the designing and awarding of the Alaska Decoration of Honor.”
- Medallion created by artist Jon Van Zyle (2009)
 - Important symbols: raven, northern lights, north star, forget-me-not, and circle
- Adjutant General submits report with those that fulfill criteria to JASC and a “Decoration of Honor Award” Concurrent Resolution is sponsored
- Medal presented along with name plate
 - “The Alaska Decoration of Honor is awarded to individuals who have made the ultimate sacrifice for our state and nation.”
