



# What are the goals?

Remove Risk	Remove the risk of unstructured draws from the Earnings Reserve Account
Resolve Tensions	Resolve the tension of choosing between spending on services versus dividends
Protect	Constitutionally protect the Permanent Fund Dividend and Power Cost Equalization Endowment
Invest	Invest our state savings with the Permanent Fund to generate more earnings
Budget	Help Alaska households and state lawmakers budget for a sustainable PFD amount indefinitely



## How does the Sustainable Dividend Account start at \$10.9 Billion?

This 4.5% draw from the Permanent Fund to the General Fund is based on the total value of the Permanent Fund, SDA, and the PCE Account together. The POMV is calculated on June 30 by the Permanent Fund Corporation from the average market value of the preceding 5 fiscal years, excluding the fiscal year that just ended.





### \$1,200 PFD: Impact to General Fund






#### Callan Returns for SJR 302 + SB 3002 Revenues
