STATE OF ALASKA 2022 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB 183

Analysis

House Bill 183 (House Judiciary Committee Substitute) creates the Alaska Criminal Justice Data Analysis Commission, which generally replaces the sunsetting Criminal Justice Commission. Alaska Statute 44.19.645(e) has required the court system to provide operational data to the Criminal Justice Commission since 2015; Section 5 of HB 183 will add a new subsection requiring the court system to provide certain additional data to the newly-named commission for its use in analyzing various aspects of the justice system.
The court system is able to provide some of the described information in an electronic format, and will be able to comply with that requirement fully by facilitating commission review of paper files. It is not anticipated that this will cause a fiscal impact on the court system, which therefore submits this zero fiscal note.
