This bill establishes a middle college program at the University of Alaska (UA). Public school students who have completed grade 8 and have not graduated, and who attend a school district who elects to participate in the program, will be eligible to earn both high school and college credit for courses as allowed by UA. This bill also allows the participating public school to receive an average daily membership (ADM) for qualifying students to be used to cover UA tuition costs. Other fees, including books and transportation, are the responsibility of the student.
This bill amends the annual reporting requirements of the State Board of Education and Early Development to include data on the middle college program, and amends the general powers and duties of UA to allow for agreements with local school districts to carry out the middle college program.
This bill establishes an effective date of July 1, 2022 (FY2023).
There is no fiscal impact to the Department of Education and Early Development under this bill.
