FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to driver's license renewal." 1

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA: 2

3	* Section 1. AS 28.15.101(a) is amended to read:
4	(a) Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, a driver's license expires on
5	the licensee's birthday in the eighth year following issuance of the license. A license
6	may be renewed [WITHIN ONE YEAR OF ITS EXPIRATION] upon proper
7	application, payment of the required fee, and except when a license is renewed under
8	(c) of this section, successful completion of a test of the licensee's eyesight
9	(1) within one year of expiration of the license; or
10	(2) within two years of expiration of the license if the licensee is
11	(A) a member of the military who is deployed, stationed, or
12	under orders to be deployed abroad; or
13	(B) a spouse or dependent of a member of the military who
14	(i) is residing abroad with a member who is
15	deployed or stationed abroad; or

1	(ii) will be residing abroad with a member who is
2	under orders to be deployed abroad.
