**Mission:** Provide consistent and efficient support services to state agencies so that they may better serve Alaskans.

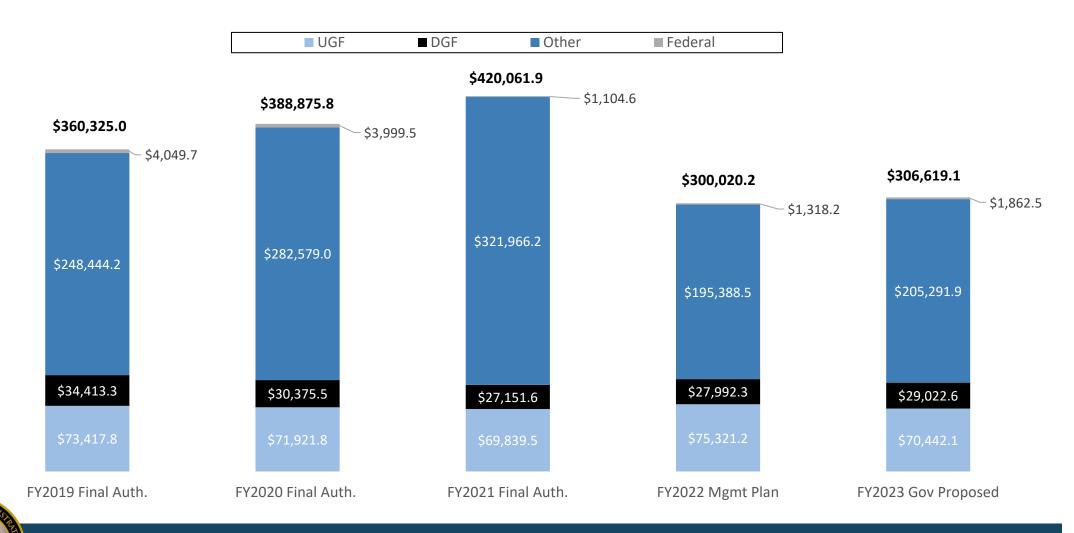

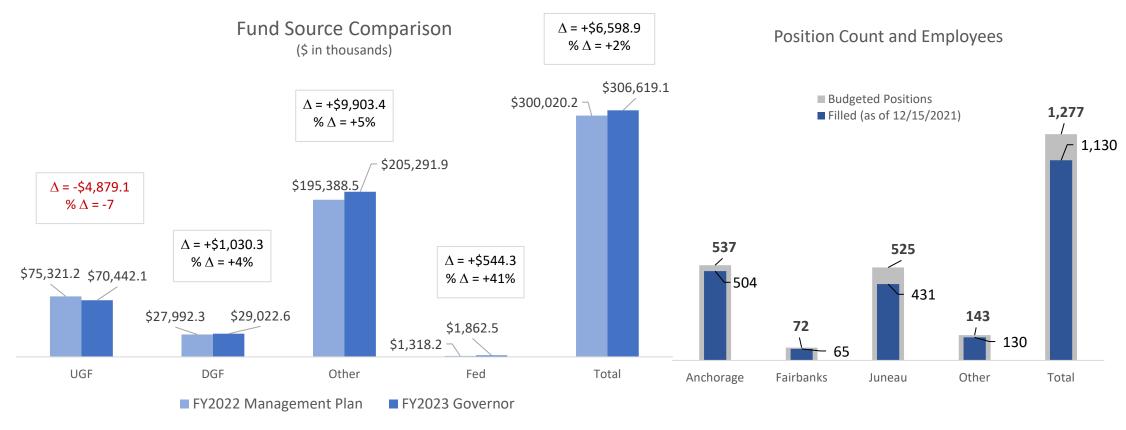

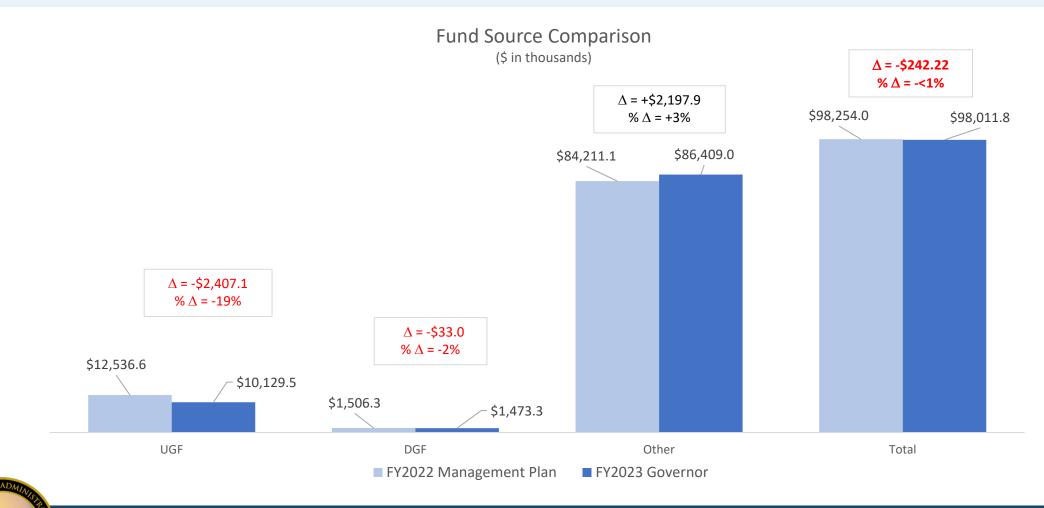

#### Dept. of Administration FY2023 Governor Operating Budget: Centralized Admin. Services

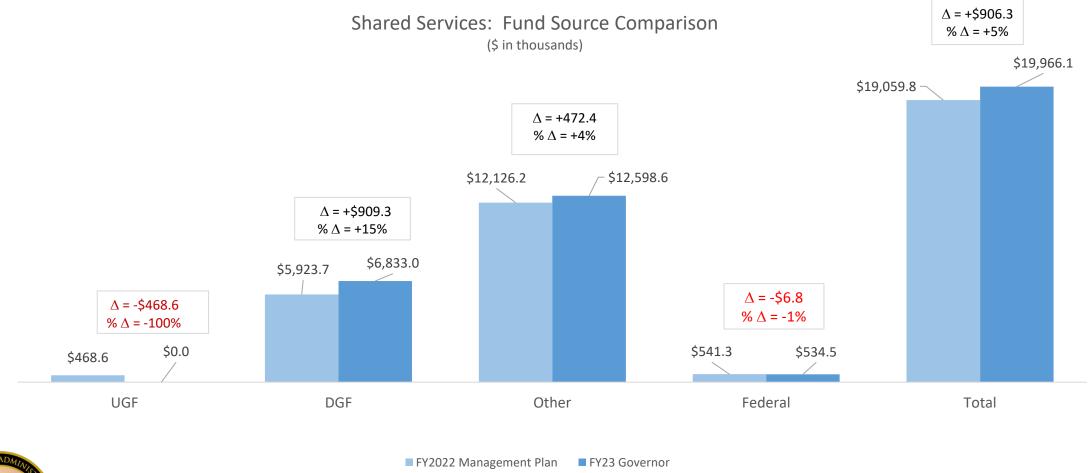

#### Dept. of Administration FY2023 Governor Operating Budget: Shared Services of Alaska

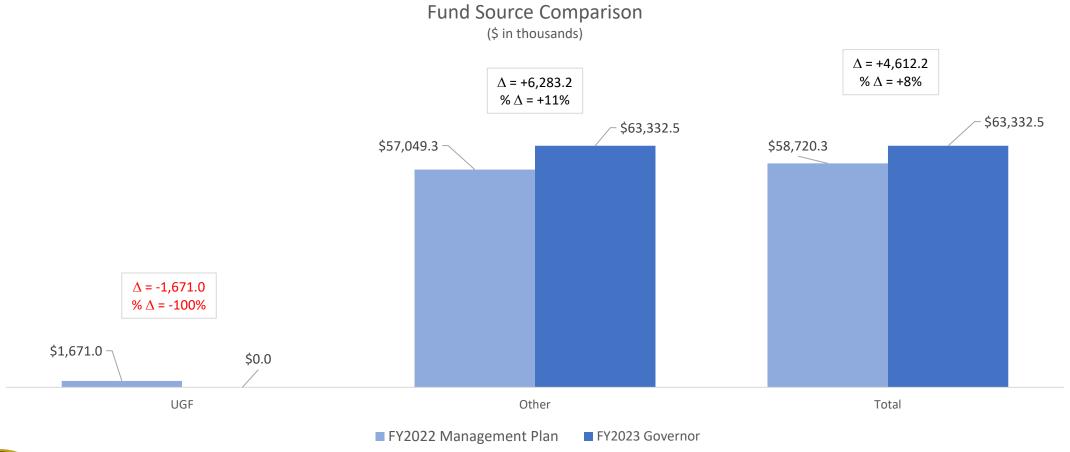

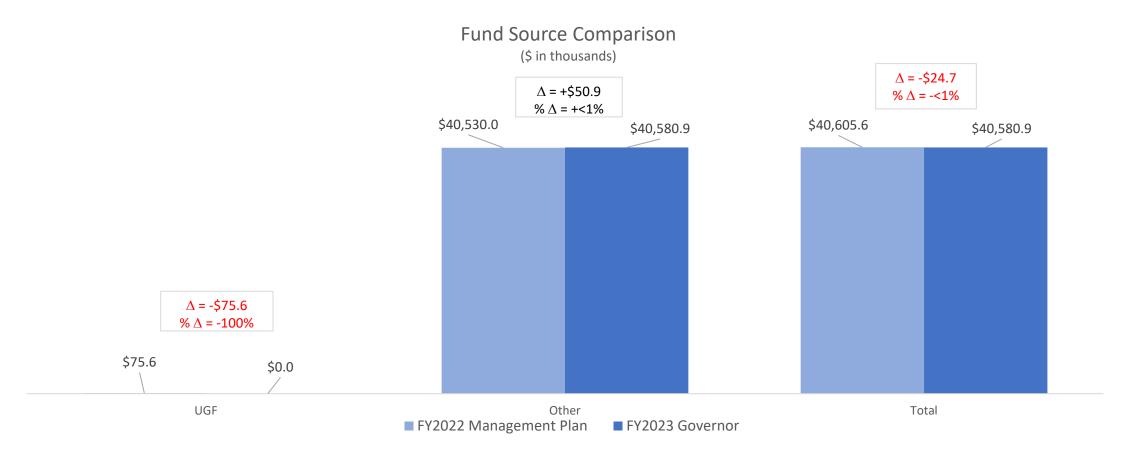

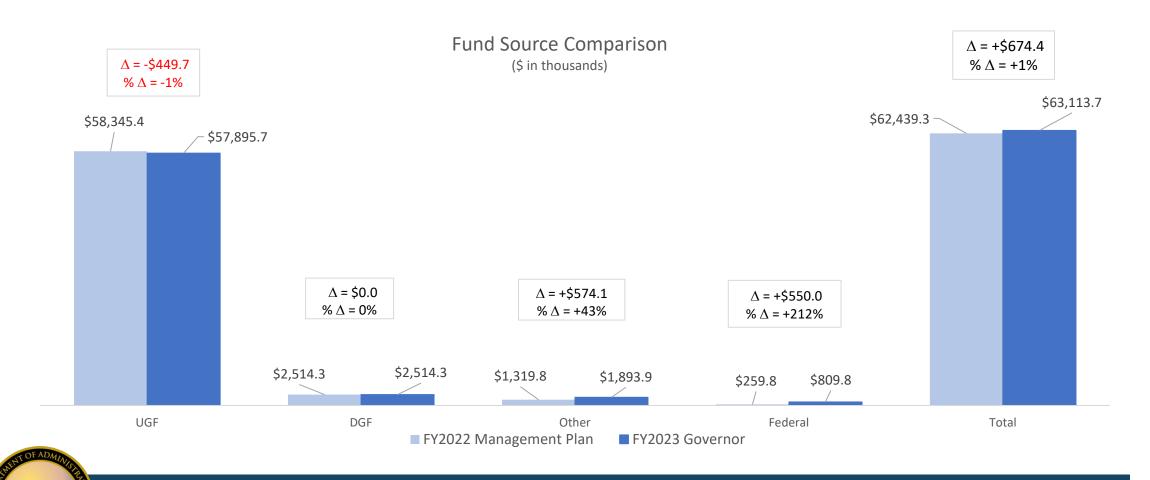

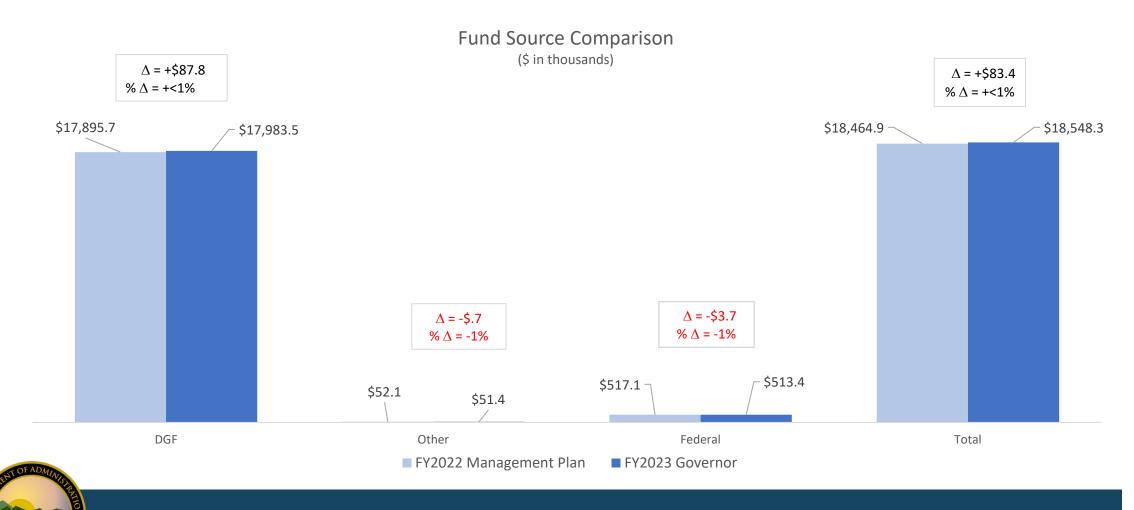
#### Dept. of Administration FY2023 Governor Operating Budget: Legal and Advocacy Services
