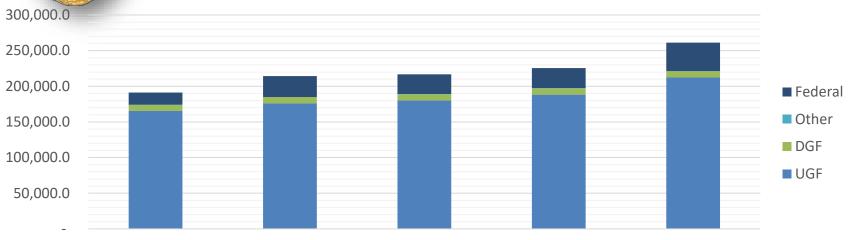
#### **Our Mission**
