The 407 students who are attending Mt. Edgecumbe High School during the 2021-2022 school year come from 107 communities. Please see the attached document titled *Mt. The below chart shows the amount of Basic Need, Deductible Impact Aid, and Total State Aid for Mt. Edgecumbe High School for FY2017 through FY2021 actuals, and what is projected for FY2022 and FY2023. The amount of federal impact aid that augments State dollars is the Deductible Impact Aid amounts highlighted below. These amounts vary by year based on the number of students eligible each year.
