Hello everyone,

In my humble opinion granting governments at any level, or businesses, the authority to compel medical procedures is a precedent I really, really don't want to be set. Granted, it's already happening however that's what this bill is about, is it not? Ending mandates and coercion aimed at forcing people to take part in human experimentation?

mRNA vaccines are experimental. They have not gone through long term clinical trials. If we accept that we can be forced to participate in these experiments, where will that stop? Will the precedent eventually be used to force people to accept surgical procedures? If you're thinking, 'no', then you might want to review human history.
