




2019 State and Local Spending (\$ Per Capita)




2019 State & Local Spending in AK was \$22,904/person, \$9,008 more per person than the national average.

What's in the State Budget? (FY 2022 Appropriations, in Billions of Dollars)




2019 State and Local Spending (\$ Per Capita)

Per capita spending in Alaska is high, but much closer to the US average when adjustments are made for the PFD, cost of living, and federal grants





Average Annual Growth in State & Local Spending in Different Periods





Average Annual Growth in State & Local Spending in Different Periods, Adjusted for Population





% Change in Nominal Per Capita State & Local Spending, 1990 to 2019



% Change in Nominal Per Capita State & Local Spending, 1990 to 2019




% Change in Nominal Per Capita State & Local Spending, 1990 to 2019



Oregon state spending grew at more than 1.5 times local spending.


North Dakota local spending grew more than state spending.

Real Per Capita State and Local Spending Alaska & US Average (1990=100)




Real Appropriations Per Person,* Unrestricted State General Fund (Adjusted for Inflation to 2016 Dollars)



Unrestricted General Fund Petroleum Revenues, FY 1975-2022 (in Millions of Dollars)




2019 Broad Based State Taxes (\$ Per Capita)






