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FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2022 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

The certificate of need process requires health service providers to obtain approval of the commissioner before building or remodeling health care facilities, or purchasing equipment costing more than an established capital expenditure threshold. Under AS 18.07.031, the existing expenditure threshold for requiring a certificate of need is \$1,500.0. Alaska is one of 31 states and the District of Columbia to have a Certificate of Need program.
This bill would repeal the Certificate of Need Program, effective July 1, 2024 (start of FY2025). The passage of this bill will require the department to adopt regulations necessary to implement the changes by July 1, 2024. There is one position that supports the program management for the Certificate of Need Program, so the passage of this bill will result in one position deletion (Medical Program Specialist IV), for an annual total cost savings of \$157.7.
