FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

Analysis

This bill increases the cost of the Celebrating the Arts plate design (aka "artistic plate") by up to \$50, and the Alaska State Council on the Arts shall determine the fee required. The proposed fee structure and process is a model that's new to DMV, so there is no historical data to base our estimations on. This analysis makes the assumption that the plate will cost \$50, and those willing to pay an added fee for an artistic personalized plate, which currently costs \$30, would be willing to pay the additional \$50 under the bill's proposed fee structure. In FY2021, 3,097 personalized artistic plates were purchased.

Forecasted Plates	Cost	Estimated Additional Revenue
3,097	\$50	\$154,850

Based on these estimations, the proposed fee structure will generate an additional **\$154,850** in revenue.

This bill also requires the the Department to separately account for the fees received under this section, from which the annual estimated remaining balance may be appropriated by the legislature to the Alaska State Council on the Arts.
