#### Senators,

I am a healthcare provider who has worked for nearly a decade in rural Alaska. I support SB 156 fully. Political discrimination under the guise of public health is disgraceful, immoral, and illegal. The inherent, civil, and privacy rights protected by our State Bill of Rights are being trampled by the public health department's encouragement of discrimination, individuals, business owners, employers, the health care facilities, and more. I am a professional Electrical Engineer that has been practicing my license in this state for over 20 years. I am not a doctor but I do know what "science" is. I know how to research, I know how to read differing opinions, I know how to fact check on my own. I don't need Snopes to tell me what is true and correct. I know when my colleges are doing wrong and I know how to complain to the licensing Board about their behavior. I also know that there are other licensed professionals that have oaths to protect the public. And I know how to complain about their behavior too!

Life, Liberty and Pursuit of Happiness. Forcing or coercing people to participate in "experimental" medical procedures which could deprive them of all three violates those principles you all swore an oath to protect. I'm writing you all to urge you to support this bill out of committee.

If there was one change I would recommend it would be to change all references "agency/agents of the state [may] not" and "persons [may] not" to "agency/agents/persons shall not...require an individual to be vaccinated against COVID-19...". The use of the term "may" connotes a meaning that gives person in authority a choice "to do" or "not to do". The term "shall" requires it!

In regards to our Alaska State Constitution please consider Article 1 that is titled INHERENT RIGHTS that says "natural rights" described as "unalienable" in our US Constitution as a little more important to our community than Article 7, (behind 6 other Articles), where Public Health is 4th down in Article 7 (as has been stated by others) behind Public Education, State University and Board of Regents. You might be persuaded that there is an intent by our founders that the obligations by the state under later Articles are fine and necessary so long as they do not cross Article 1 INHERENT RIGHTS. Which is why it is stated first. In the current climate right now people are being abridged of either life, liberty or pursuit of their happiness, and in the case of the Alaska Constitution (also added by our State founders) the "enjoyment of the rewards of their own industry" when being required to subject themselves to unproven medical procedures or lose their jobs. There are currently no state laws that gives the government or any employer that right to abridge the US Constitution. So in effect people are already being denied their State Constitution Article 1 rights, including that of another Article 1 right in section 7 called Due Process. To me that means there is no law or process that allows the state to deny these rights, so technically for the last 2 years they (the State and/or private employers) shouldn't have been allowed by any court of law interpreting the statutes to fire people for not being vaccinated. This bill would prevent any courts from "interpreting" the statutes to allow abridging our people these rights. I for one would rather have it spelled out plainly in statute so a Governor cannot issue executive orders over it. Or a Judge cannot "rule against" it. Or a legislator cannot propose to change it without appropriate public response. Please make it easier for us that oppose the action of requiring vaccines to fight the court system. If this Bill could somehow be conceived as unconstitutional then let the minority and whatever lawyer money they have try to disprove it within the judicial system. This Bill, if approved into law would make it incumbent on a small proportion of people (in this state) to prove if there are benefits against it.

None of us want a tyrannical government telling us everything that we can and cannot do; nor empowering employers to do the same. To me this includes actions of both the legislature and the executive, as well as the judiciary that must make sense, and (as always) decide what ambiguous laws mean. This is most especially true if it violates the constitution for which this state (and our country) is founded. I think the point of this bill is that it protects the will of the people to make their own determinations. Article 1 Section 2, the very next clause after Article 1 Section 1

# INHERENT RIGHTS is "All political power is inherent in the people. All government originates with the people, is founded upon their will only, and is instituted solely for the good of the people as a whole."

Notice that "for the good of the people" is third behind "ORIGINATES with the people" and "founded upon their will <u>ONLY</u>". To me this means that regardless of what the "political science" says, our people in this state have a say in how they are governed. Which is why regardless of what you think about this bill it should at the very least be pushed out of your committee to be able to see the light of day. Maybe in the old days bills like this could be buried. But as has been stated by some "It's clear there is a lot of interest in this bill." I for one am interested. As are many of your own constituents, I presume.

Senate HHS Committee Members,

Please see my attached pdf Testimony Letter in SUPPORT of SB 156, Covid-19 Vaccine Discrimination.

My name is Brittany Lauper, I live in Anchorage. I am writing to have my concerns be heard and to state that I fully support the proposed Senate Bill 156 to protect our God given rights to bodily autonomy.

In 2013, at age 27, I was diagnosed with a genetic disorder called Lynch Syndrome which causes my genes to mutate and attack my body and caused me to develop Colorectal cancer; by God's grace he healed me from that. Lynch Syndrome also gives me a much higher possibility of developing other cancers and unfortunately, I haven't been unable to get my yearly preventative exams due to the unreasonable requirements of the Doctor's offices & Surgery Centers i.e., being forced to suffocate with a mask and swabbing my nose with toxic chemicals Additionally, I'm terrified of anything happening during an exam that could put me in the hospital. I've seen what is happening and how they treat people (especially the un-inoculated people) these past 2 years.

The mRNA gene editing technology that these injections use affects the DNA & genes of the person receiving it - and I will not risk testing them on my body for any reason. There is no transparency, no informed consent and when we ask questions, we are demonized. Even if these weren't experimental, I still would not test them on my body without being FULLY informed which the FDA is obviously not willing to permit as observed by their past & current actions. No elaboration on how it could affect someone with Lynch Syndrome and DNA disorder. When I respectfully asked her "is this your medical opinion that it's safe for me and my personal medical history? Or is this your personal ethical opinion because you think I should get it?" And she said it's her personal ethical opinion and she believes everyone should get it... then adding "You could probably find an anti-vax doctor in town that would sign your medical exemption." This, to me, is medical malpractice.

The audacity of a government thinking they can force something into my body and implement a blanket mandate over every human with NO regard to personal medical circumstances or religious beliefs is not only unconstitutional, but an egregious human rights violation. Additionally, to require us to jump through stressful, time consuming & financially costly hoops to get a medical or religious exemption - that has been shown to likely be denied by most employers - only to put us on a government list to keep track of the exemptions that are accepted, makes me feel like less of a human.

The stress and anxiety caused from the threats of losing our ability to make an income is not to be downplayed either. This is NOT about my health. This is NOT about my safety. This is about the federal government being able to persecute us and control our lives - indefinitely. This is not right... Something very, very bad is happening here.

This medical experiment they are coercing many confused & fearful people to a part of is nothing less than criminal. I know you have seen the unbelievable numbers of deaths and injuries caused from this. I do not understand how anyone is still pretending like this is any kind of cure for getting back to our normal free lives. <u>Anyone who is injected can get this illness and still spread it.</u> It's completely illogical.

It is YOUR DUTY to secure & protect our rights. Emergency power is NOT a governing power in our state. We need to hear more of our state leaders taking a bold stand and speaking up about the dangers of this shot. If we the "little people" are aware of the data - you must be aware too. Being willfully ignorant will not be acceptable when this is exposed for what it is. I will not accept this as "safe and effective". It is a lie. <u>There is no evidence this is safe OR</u> <u>effective</u>. <u>There are no successful safety studies</u>. It is dangerous and it is killing people. Citizens are being coerced to choose treatments inappropriate for them based on their personal medical history and beliefs.

The following is my personal experience with this current injustice.:

I was employed from 6/29/2015 to 9/10/2021 (over 6 years) with Chugach Training & Educational Services LLC at Alaska Job Corps in Palmer as a Medical Record Clerk in the Wellness Clinic.

(This included working from home 2 days a week for several months during the 2020 COVID restrictions period 4/2020-11/2020- all staff was tested before our staff and students were allowed to begin to return to Center.)

About 3 PM on Friday 8/27/2021, a user wide email was sent from our Center Director informing us that due to the Biden issued COVID vaccination mandate, as of 9/01/2021 all employees were required to show verification of COVID-19 vaccination or to complete & show verification of negative COVID-19 tests 3 times a week to have access to the Alaska Job Corps Center to continue working.

Due to religious and health reasons, I do not wish to risk taking the vaccine, and feel that is is discriminatory to request only unvaccinated persons to test, as vaccinated persons can still contract and spread the virus.

I expressed my concerns and beliefs to my Center Director who indicated the order was issued due to the Federal mandate.

I worked the following Monday 8/30 & Tuesday 8/31 and submitted my remaining leave time through 9/10/2021 in hopes of a change in policy. (I had already entered leave for Friday 9/3 for an extended 4 day Labor Day weekend).

on 9/13/2021 Monday, I spoke to HR and informed her I would need to turn in my keys and ID if policy had not changed. I was asked to write a letter of resignation. I indicated I was not resigning, but being forced to find employment elsewhere to earn income to survive since they were not allowing me on Center to work and wrote a letter to that effect upon submitting my keys & ID.

I applied for state unemployment benefits on 9/14/2021 online and have been continuing to file weekly claims and submitting required job searches.

I received a phone call from AKUIB for details of my employment separation and was highly offended to be subjected to having to justify my personal and medical reasons for my decision.

On 10/17/2021 I received a letter in my PO box postmarked 10/14/2021 (letter dated 10/13/2021) from UI Claim Center. The UI Claim Center letter indicated they determined that I did not establish good cause for voluntarily leaving my work & therefore denied benefits from application until 10/23/2021 as well as having my maximum payable benefits reduced by 3 times my weekly benefit amount.

I did not receive ANY UIB benefits until 12/3, have been seeking new employment, and NOT as of yet received a hearing date for my appeal.

As a 62 year old voting taxpayer who has worked since I was 12 years old, I am astonished at the injustice I am receiving.

I fully support SB156. Please stand in support of personal liberty. I was harmed by vaccination and masking requirements by being denied medical treatment during childbirth. Please consider my testimony.

When I was in labor with my second child, I was unfortunately transferred to Bartlett Regional Hospital in Juneau. I had been laboring for over 40 hours, and my body was trying to push my body also wasn't ready, so I had to fight the urge to push. This was the hardest thing I have ever had to do in my entire life. It was all I could do to focus my eyes on a spot on the ceiling and breathe deep breaths until the all consuming urge to push that baby out passed. If I gave in to my instincts, I would damage myself and likely need surgery. When I got to the hospital, I needed an epidural. Not for the pain, but to slow my labor down and help my body relax and finish dilating. It was medically necessary.

When I arrived at the hospital, despite being told that there would be someone there waiting at the entrance to escort me to my room, I was harassed by a young man at a COVID screening booth. I was moaning in pain, using all of my effort to focus on breathing and not pushing. There was a policy on the books at Bartlett exempting laboring mothers from needing to wear a mask. Nonetheless, the man from the screening booth followed me into the elevator and forcefully held a mask over my face with his hand until I was in my room, against my verbal protest.

I knew that my son was going to be born with club feet, and with no pediatric orthopedic specialists in Juneau, I knew that I would likely be needing to travel. This was January 2021, when the State of Alaska still had travel restrictions. I had written on my birth plan, and I verbalized to my care providers at Bartlett that I did not consent to a COVID test, because if it were positive, I would not be able to travel to seek the necessary immediate treatment for my son's condition. Nonetheless, they refused to submit the order for my epidural until I consented to a COVID test. I did not consent. They denied me medical care because I was unvaccinated and refused to be tested. I was tested anyway, and the epidural order was put in. My son was born 8 hours later, and I did need to urgently travel to Anchorage for treatment. Had I tested positive, my son would not have been able to seek necessary medical treatment because of airline and state travel restrictions.

This was wrong. I was denied medical care, at the detriment of the health of myself and my unborn child, to "minimize risk" for staff who had it within their power to just wear higher grade protective gear if they were not comfortable with the risk of their profession.

Dear Chairperson and Members of the Senate Health and Social Services committee:

Thank you for allowing me to present some of the latest information on COVID vaccinations, made public yesterday by New York's Department of Health and by the United Kingdom's Department of Health and Social Care, today.

The data from over 365,000 children aged 5 through 11 in New York state revealed that *by one month after they were fully vaccinated, there was almost no protection remaining against COVID.* By five weeks, fully vaccinated children aged 5-11 were at *higher risk* of developing COVID than unvaccinated children, with the increase in risk becoming even greater over time.

For 852,000 New York children aged 12 through 17, protection after one month ranged between 40% and 67%, dropping gradually but steadily over the next several weeks.

While it might seem that boosters could be the answer, Europe's FDA, termed the European Medicines Agency, warned against too many boosters and their potential to cause immune damage on January 13, 2022.

Unfortunately, we are finally coming around to acknowledge that is no way to control the spread of COVID and its variants. For that reason, many states are already lifting their mask mandates and vaccine mandates are starting to go away.

In the UK, COVID vaccine mandates for health care workers were recently lifted. And an online poll of 90,000 people, conducted by the UK government and published today, found that 90% of respondents wanted no healthcare worker mandates, while only 9% were in favor of them.

Both the data and the people have spoken. Vaccine mandates for children make no scientific sense. Vaccine mandates for healthcare workers are unwanted by both the workers themselves and the public they serve.

Discrimination by vaccination status, when the benefit of vaccination rapidly declines, and the vaccinated can catch and spread COVID, is illogical and arbitrary. Please vote in favor of SB156.

# *Pfizer Shot Is Far Less Effective in 5- to 11-Year-Olds Than in Older Kids, New Data Show*

While protection against hospitalization is still strong, the vaccine offered almost no protection against infection, even just a month after full vaccination.

" The Pfizer vaccine is the only Covid shot authorized for that age group in the United States. It still prevents severe illness in the children, but **offers virtually no protection against infection, even within a month after full immunization**, the data, which were collected during the Omicron surge, suggest.

The sharp drop in the vaccine's performance in young children may stem from the fact that they receive one-third the dose given to older children and adults, researchers and federal officials who have reviewed the data said.

The findings, <u>which were posted online on Monday</u>, come on the heels of clinical trial results indicating that **the vaccine fared poorly in children aged 2 to 4 years**, who received an even smaller dose.

Experts worried that the news would further dissuade hesitant parents from immunizing their children. **Other studies have shown the vaccine was not powerfully protective against infection with the Omicron variant in adults, either**.

"It's disappointing, but not entirely surprising, given this is a vaccine developed in response to an earlier variant," said Eli Rosenberg, deputy director for science at the New York State Department of Health, who led the study. "**It looks very distressing to see this rapid decline, but it's again all against Omicron...**"

The World Health Organization has repeatedly said that providing first doses to poorer nations is a higher priority than richer nations offering boosters..."

I would really appreciate it if our legislators would send a clear and resounding reminder to every organization, agency, employer, corporation, and group that Alaskans are still free. I would appreciate you even more if you would help to reverse the misinformation that the virus, that so many fear, requires a vaccination when in reality has a 99.8% survival rate. Put an end to the far reaching medical discrimination that has taken hold.

I was laid off from the north slope on the first day that all employees were required to wear a non-prescribed medical device over their faces in April 2020. Even dinner napkins were distributed to drape over our faces in the absence of any other covering. I have yet to find suitable employment that doesn't require a mask or an injection as a condition of employment. Consequently, my unemployment benefits ran out in December 2020.

Over the past 2 summers, I travelled to where my family is from in Western Alaska to go to fish camp. Summer 2020, we were required to complete paperwork and show proof of negative "tests". I was compliant. Summer 2021, the village of Unalakleet demanded paperwork to be completed, proof of a covid synthetic gene mutation shot otherwise currently referred to as a covid vaccine or proof of a negative test. (The shot or test were also required as a condition of travel for one of the air carriers). This time, I did not participate in that behavior. Upon arrival at the airport, I was asked by a stranger at the ticket counter for private health information (which I politely pointed out to them), then I answered their questions honestly. I was then told that I wouldn't be able to travel. I rejected that opinion and at that point they called Unalakleet and passed the phone to me. The lady on the phone identified herself as some covid team member and again a stranger asked for my health information, again I pointed out that she was asking me for private information, but despite that, I would answer. She replied that I would have to reschedule my travel until I had proof of a negative test. My question, was "under whose authority?" She replied that this was from this tri-villages covid team, or something like that. I replied that this team had not purchased my tickets. Upon my arrival in Unalakleet, I was met by the covid team representative and the Unalakleet police. They told me that I had to step outside to talk to them, where I was told that I had to fill out the paperwork. Incidentally, their paperwork includes all of my personal details (name, residence address, phone number), purpose for travel, destination, vaccination status, quarantine options. By signing the paperwork, a person is agreeing that they will comply and if not, agrees to fines of \$250-\$1000 and refusal to complete incurs a \$500 fine. I am not yet aware of any consequences for my non-participation. I had pointed out to them that the year prior, they were requiring proof of a negative test. This year they were requiring proof on an injection or a negative test, what would they require next year? A mark on my forehead or on my right hand? This is straight out of the book of Revelation in the Bible. This is exactly where they are so boldy leading us and at the same time thriving financially from funds provided by the federal government.

My life has been turned upside down by the fear that everyone is harboring. I spent 6 weeks (Feb – March 2021) traveling up and down the east coast without a mask and without an injection and miraculously survived without event (other than the dramatics of those that promote fear).

Please restore freedom in our state, the freedoms that corporations and government are trying to eliminate.

Thank you for taking my Testimony. I'm Donna Celia. I'm an Anchorage resident, and I was not able to give verbal testimony on this item. So I have included my comments below.

I would urge the Senate to pass SB 156. Vaccine discrimination has had a distinct personal impact on my family. Even though this legislation cannot affect the workplace discrimination for us, I thought our experience may be informative for this committee.

My husband is a member of the AK National Guard and works full time at a DOD civilian job. His prior military record includes four deployments to war zones, and he has served in active duty and guard service for nearly 15 years. He applied for a religious accommodation at both his jobs.

So, now every Thursday at work he is forced to enter the building through a special door for "unvaxxed only," he is forced to wear a mask on Thursdays only, and he is forced to take a toxic, self-administered covid test once a week, every Thursday. He jokingly named this "National Discrimination Day." He has repeatedly asked his leadership whether this process is part of the presidential mandate, or if it is the "accommodation" that he requested. His leadership regularly reverses themselves on which one of these things it is. If it is part of the "mandate" then how is it possible to segregate his shop into "Vaxxed" and "Unvaxxed" when vaccinated personnel can still catch, spread, be hospitalized and die from Covid? Why aren't vaccinated people being tested too? But if it is the "accommodation," then why is there no evidence that the government has granted his request? The IG personally informed him that no civilian personnel in his unit have received a religious accommodation. So, you see, the Federal Government is presently trying to have its cake and eat it too. Meanwhile producing a hostile work environment for its finest employees, in which they are forced to use separate doors, separate seating areas, wear a mask which marks them out as "unvaccinated" people, and they are subjected to different healthcare policies. This is functionally no different that telling "colored people" to use a different water fountain, or forcing "colored" people to attend different schools. Even though this discrimination is not race-based, it is discrimination against people who express strong religious objections to the vaccine. So, this is illegal discrimination based on religion, which is already against the 1964 Civil Rights Act.

At the Guard, where he is a first sergeant to an undisclosed unit (undisclosed for his privacy), he will be making a decision within one week of today as to whether he will sign up for his final re-enlistment. He always wanted to complete a full career of service with the US Air Force/AKANG. He has an exemplary record. But now he has to wonder whether his next career move will put him into a discrimination trap. You see, he still has not received approval for his religious accommodation request. And even if he does receive an approval (which is enormously unlikely), he recognizes that the military can arbitrarily determine that his religious objection to the Covid vaccine will render him "unready to deploy" which will mean he could be dishonorably discharged. This policy makes him uncertain that, despite his best efforts throughout 15 years and 4 deployments, not even a SINGLE piece of bad paperwork, he could have his whole record of service destroyed simply for standing up for his religious beliefs. Isn't this exactly the kind of man you want to defend your constitutional rights? Yet, he, and others like him, may very well decline to further protect this country. What kind of people will take his place? I will restate: this policy is DESPITE the growing evidence that vaccines DO NOT prevent infection, spread, hospitalization, or death. So what do they do, other than destroy morale and harm our national security?

Websters Dictionary defines the term "anti-vaxxer" as a person who opposes the use of vaccines or regulations mandating vaccination. But you'll see if you look at their website, that this definition was changed in October 2021. So, according to Webster's Dictionary, my support for SB 156 makes me an "anti-vaxxer." A derogatory epithet that applies to anyone who opposes vaccine mandates!

I'm giving you this perspective because SB 156 will protect Alaskan citizens from a similar fate. I urge you to acknowledge the insidious and divisive nature of vaccine mandates and vaccine passports. #### SUPPLEMENTAL ADDITION TO MY TESTIMONY,

from Dr. Joan Priestley, M.D.

Dear Committee members-

I am writing to provide further information concerning the relative risks to children, from the vaccines and from COVID infection.

Data from the Pfizer application for authorization in children revealed that not one child in the control group died, was hospitalized, or even had a severe infection. That is how children respond to COVID- they have a mild case, and bounce back. Hard to improve on that outcome.

The CDC Advisory Committee determined that the death of one child would be prevented, for every million doses given to children.

Each child get two doses, so 500,000 kids need to be vaccinated, to save one child's death.

However, the vaccine results in many side effects. Let's look at just myocarditis. Its incidence is between 1 : 2,600 (Hong Kong study), to 1 : 6,600 (Israeli study). I took an average of the two- 1 : 4,600.

The math is simple. Vaccinating 500,000 children will result in 108 cases of myocarditis. Let's pare that down to just 100 cases. Myocarditis is a serious medical problem.

30% of those cases will completely resolve (30 children). 20% will have their lives restricted and shortened (20 children). They will likely die of heart failure, stroke or heart attacks within 20 years.

50% will be completely disabled, and they will likely die within 5 years. That is 50 previously healthy children, who will lose their lives for the sake of preventing one COVID death.

The provisions of SB 156 help secure parental rights, to protect children from this needless and dangerous vaccine. Please consider these facts, when voting on SB 156.

My name is Cody Loomis and I'm in Sitka.

Thank you for this opportunity to participate in our lawmaking process.

I greatly appreciate the intent of SB 156, and I appreciate the protection that it would provide if passed as written. My critique today is to caution the lawmakers about the specificity of the language in SB 156, my understanding of the language in the bill, is that it would only prohibit a vaccine passport implemented due to covid 19. I believe this is a limiting factor that has the potential to hobble it's effectiveness.

The infrastructure for a personal smart device/phone based digital health passport is currently in place, and is being implemented all over the world, and in some parts of this country. In the event that this digital health pass is implemented, It doesn't require a lot of mental gymnastics to imagine an American society that is more like the CCP social credit system than the free society that we used to occupy just a few short years ago. In the hands of a government with nefarious intent, the implementation of a digital health pass FOR ANY PATHOGEN OR DISEASE could usher in a state of tyranny and authoritarianism that we Alaskans have only read about in history books, or seen unfold on our news cycle in other parts of the country. In the instance where this becomes a reality, we will see people fight against this in any way that they have available to them. I implore you, remedy this situation before it escalates any further.

I have a couple of specific concerns with the language in this bill.

My first concern is that it seems that this bill would only protect Alaskans from vaccine passports that are implemented due to covid-19. If there is a variant in the future, designated SarsCOV3, or covid-22, or a different virus completely, will this legislation as written protect Alaskans from authoritarian tyrannical social credit systems implemented for anything other than covid-19?

The other issue that I have, is that the 10<sup>th</sup> amendment of the constitution of the United States already prohibits the Federal Government from wielding any power that is not explicitly granted to it by an act of congress or the constitution.

The FDA, the CDC, Government funded hospitals, and the state health authorities should not, and do not have enforcement authority for their recommended public health policies. In the lack of a state of emergency declaration by the governor, health mandates in place are illegal to enforce, and therefore the local municipal police, and the state troopers should be protecting Alaskan's rights. But they have not been doing anything close to this. They should be responding to this illegal behavior with investigations, and protection of the people. Where are the Alaska state troopers to protect and serve the population? why are local police not protecting the constitutional rights of civilians? We have a serious accountability problem in this state with our law enforcement agencies, and the duration of these blatant civil liberties violations lays bare the necessity for an elected protector of the citizens rights. The state legislature must implement a law enforcement agency that answers only to the people, and is sworn to protect their constitutional rights as a primary directive. Just as an elected sheriff is the ultimate law authority in counties in the lower 48, Alaska needs the equivalent of a sheriff and deputies for each borough in the state to ensure that this kind of sustained and blatant allowance of individual liberty and suspension of bodily autonomy never happens again.

I appreciate that SB 156 will start the process of restoring the social contract between those who are governed, and those who are governing.

I have another concern that is more abstract. It is that Passing this legislation as written, tacitly agrees, that the federal government does have the power to enforce it's bureaucratic health decrees on everyone, and therefore, a state law is required to counter that power.

If a state law is necessary to protect Alaskans from federal interference in their personal health decisions, those lawmakers reading this, should rewrite this bill to prohibit public health passes in their entirety for any reason, and prohibit compulsory compliance in any and all public health mandates outside of a state of emergency.

I fear it is a grave mistake To limit this legislation to measures implemented only due to covid-19, and to limit this prohibition on medical discrimination only to state entities is a grave mistake. Protect the citizens rights that you represent, not a single person who wants to engage in mitigations will be prohibited to do so by this bill.

I am concerned that to forward this bill as written, should it pass and become law, is to invite the same institutions and bureaucracies currently trampling our individual liberty, to come up with another reason to implement their tyranny and oppression through a public health pass, or vaccine passport in response to the next public health threat that on a long enough timeline, will undoubtedly occur.

Thank you for your work on this matter, I truly appreciate the efforts of the lawmakers who have taken on this most contentious issue. Thank you for your service to the state of Alaska, and your service to the citizens who make up it's populace.



It meant that our family was sequestered, isolated and are still seeing and feeling the effects of that in a larger sense even today.

I support this bill 100%. No government entity, private organization or publicly funded group should tell each of us what we should and should not do with our bodies.

Two of my children and I have two rare, genetic blood-clotting disorders, which are the main reason preventing us from seeking out any version of this vaccine. Had I complied with the many entities bullying us to get the vaccine and that it was safe, we would not be here today. We would be dead. There is absolutely no question about it. . My doctor stands by this statement with medical proof.

We have been cut off from friends, relatives, church, employers, travel opportunities, our medical care facilities and services, and for awhile even our own public library... all because we don't carry around a white Covid vaccine card and could not comply with the mandate.

This Bill is essential for the safety and well-being of my children and future generations to come. I am pleading with Senators who do not see eye to eye on this topic to call me, come to my home, I am willing to provide as many details, documents and discourse about what it has been like to live through the experience of being silenced, being treated as "less than" all because of this particular requirement and the unnecessary mandates.

Testimony of Lawrence D. Wood in support of SB156

I am a 67 year Alaskan, married for 49 years, whose wife, Lydia, is a retired elementary teacher with 27 years experience in Alaska, whose children and their families live in Alaska. I am a retired businessman in mining, mining equipment and soil remediation equipment development, soil remediation, construction, with 18 years in telephony. I reside at 4750 Wolverine Rd., Palmer, Alaska 99645.

I support SB156 as necessary and as a needed end to the specter of abuse against the individual. There is no basis in science or medical practice for what has happened and is still happening with the fear mongering and forced inoculation using vaccines that are truly experimental and which are now shown to have a far greater propensity for harm than previously admitted by government.

Business and government have acted out of fear, misinformation, in an outright subterfuge in the attempt to suborn the rights of the individual in mandating these experimental vaccines for reasons now demonstrated to be without basis in science or fact, given the focus is the healthy population demonstrated to be least susceptible to the COVID virus—0-30 years of age without co-morbidities.
