Page 1, line 1:

Delete "**and**"

Page 1, line 2, following "**vaccine**":

Insert "**; and relating to COVID-19 vaccination status and eligibility for health care insurance**"

Page 2, following line 30:

Insert a new bill section to read:

**"\* Sec. 2.** AS 21.54.100(a) is amended to read:

(a) A health care insurer that offers, issues for delivery, delivers, or renews a health care insurance plan in the group market may not establish rules for eligibility, including continued eligibility and waiting periods under the plan, for an individual or dependent of an individual based on

- (1) health status;
- (2) medical condition, including physical and mental illnesses;
- (3) claims experience;
- (4) receipt of health care;
- (5) medical history;
- (6) genetic information;
- (7) evidence of insurability, including conditions arising from acts of domestic violence; [OR]
- (8) disability; **or**

1                    (9) the individual's COVID-19 vaccination status; in this  
2                    paragraph, "COVID-19" has the meaning given in AS 18.09.290."
