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Alaska Communities Without Nearby Health Care Facilities

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What communities in Alaska are located beyond a 100-mile radius of certain types of health care facilities licensed and/or certified by the state?

To determine what communities are located beyond a 100-mile radius of certain types of health care facilities, we examined the list of health care facilities currently licensed and/or certified by the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS).¹ Specifically, we looked for the following types of facilities in the state: ambulatory surgical center (20); general acute care hospital (11); Alaska Native tribal hospital (7); long-term acute care hospital (2); critical access hospital (2); frontier extended stay clinic (2); or rural primary care hospital (1).² There are 21 communities in the state, listed in the table on the following page, where one or more of these health care facilities are present.

Furthermore, based on geographic data provided by the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development, Research and Analysis Section, we identified 111 communities in the state that lie beyond a 100-mile radius of a community with one or more of the selected types of facilities. In other words, there are 111 communities that (a) lack any facility that is among those types of facilities and (b) are at least 100 miles distant from a community that offers such a health care facility. The list of these 111 communities also appears in the table on the following page.

Along with the enclosed table, we also provide a map, titled "Alaskan Communities Beyond a 100-Mile Radius of Selected Health Care Facilities," produced by the Research and Analysis Section of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development for the purposes of this report.

² Other types of facilities licensed and/or certified by DHSS are as follows: birthing center; home health agency; nursing facility; volunteer hospice; full service hospice; end stage renal disease facility; outpatient physical therapy/speech pathology services; and specialized (psychiatric) hospital. In every case, these more specialized types of facilities share a geographic region with (i.e. are within a 100-mile radius of) the types of health care facilities that we selected for the purposes of this report.
