MV Lituya | Currently in Service

Currently providing service between Ketchikan and Annette Bay.

MV Matanuska | Currently in Service

Currently providing service from Bellingham to the communities of Ketchikan, Wrangell, Petersburg, Kake, Sitka, Juneau, Haines and Skagway.

MV Aurora | Currently in Service

Currently providing service to the communities of Whittier, Cordova, Valdez, Tatitlek and Chenega Bay in Prince William Sound.

MV Tazlina | Currently in Service

Currently providing service to northern panhandle communities including Angoon, Gustavus, Hoonah, Juneau, Haines, and Skagway.

MV LeConte | Currently in Overhaul

The LeConte is at Vigor Shipyard Ketchikan for its annual winter overhaul through March 28th, 2022.

MV Kennicott | Currently in Overhaul

The Kennicott is at Vigor Shipyard Ketchikan for its annual winter overhaul through April 21st, 2022

MV Tustumena | Currently in Overhaul

The Tustumena is at JAG Shipyard Seward starting their federal CIP. The Tustumena is expected to return to service on July 7th, 2022.

MV Columbia | Currently in Overhaul Status

Vessel is currently in overhaul at the Ketchikan Shipyard. Finalizing overhaul boiler work.

MV Hubbard | Currently in Layup

Federal CIP project has been awarded. Vessel CIP has started at Vigor shipyard Ketchikan.

MV Malaspina | Currently in Layup

Vessel currently laid up in Ward Cove, Ketchikan Alaska. Layup status is the result of insufficient operating funds. Approximately \$45 million needed for steel repair work and overhaul.
