FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. HB203

Analysis

This bill amends the crime of misconduct involving weapons in the fourth degree, AS 11.61.210(a) (9), to include someone owning a firearm which is used by another, who is prohibited from owning a firearm, resulting in an injury or during the commission of a crime. Misconduct involving weapons in the fourth degree is a class A misdemeanor.

This bill also adds a new offense, misconduct involving weapons in the sixth degree. A person owning a firearm would commit this new offense if the firearm is not under the control of the owner or authorized person, if the owner does not secure a firearm, or if an owner knows that a prohibited person is able to gain access to the firearm.

It is unknown, as a result of the violation, how many misconduct involving weapons in the fourth degree convictions may occur during the course of law enforcement investigations. Therefore, the fiscal impact of this legislation is indeterminate.
