A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to eligibility for the permanent fund dividend; and providing for an
2 effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 43.23.005(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) An individual is eligible to receive one permanent fund dividend each year
6 in an amount to be determined under AS 43.23.025 if the individual

7 (1) applies to the department;

8 (2) is a state resident on the date of application;

9 (3) was a state resident during the entire qualifying year;

10 (4) has been physically present in the state for at least **168** [72]
11 consecutive hours [AT SOME TIME] during the [PRIOR] two years before the
12 current dividend year, **regardless of whether the individual is claiming an absence**
13 **under AS 43.23.008;**

14 (5) is

1 (A) a citizen of the United States;

2 (B) an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence in the
3 United States;

4 (C) an alien with refugee status under federal law; or

5 (D) an alien that has been granted asylum under federal law;

6 (6) was, at all times during the qualifying year, physically present in
7 the state or, if absent, was absent only as allowed in AS 43.23.008; and

8 (7) was in compliance during the qualifying year with the military
9 selective service registration requirements imposed under 50 U.S.C. App. 453
10 (Military Selective Service Act), if those requirements were applicable to the
11 individual, or has come into compliance after being notified of the lack of compliance.

12 * **Sec. 2.** AS 43.23.008(a) is amended to read:

13 (a) Subject to (b) and (d) of this section, an otherwise eligible individual who
14 is absent from the state during the qualifying year remains eligible for a current year
15 permanent fund dividend if the individual is [WAS] absent

16 (1) receiving secondary or postsecondary education on a full-time
17 basis;

18 (2) receiving vocational, professional, or other specific education on a
19 full-time basis for which, as determined by the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary
20 Education, a comparable program is not reasonably available in the state;

21 (3) **because the individual is**

22 **(A) deployed or travelling on a temporary duty assignment**
23 **while** serving on active duty as a member of the armed forces of the United
24 States; or

25 **(B)** accompanying, as **the** [THAT INDIVIDUAL'S] spouse,
26 minor dependent, or disabled dependent **of** [,] an individual who is

27 **(i) described under (A) of this paragraph** [(A)
28 SERVING ON ACTIVE DUTY AS A MEMBER OF THE ARMED
29 FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES]; and

30 **(ii)** [(B)] eligible for a current year dividend;

31 (4) serving under foreign or coastal articles of employment aboard an

1 oceangoing vessel of the United States merchant marine;

2 (5) receiving continuous medical treatment recommended by a
3 licensed physician or convalescing as recommended by the physician who treated the
4 illness if the treatment or convalescence is not based on a need for climatic change;

5 (6) providing care for a parent, spouse, sibling, child, or stepchild with
6 a critical life-threatening illness whose treatment plan, as recommended by the
7 attending physician, requires travel outside the state for treatment at a medical
8 specialty complex;

9 (7) providing care for the individual's terminally ill family member;

10 (8) settling the estate of the individual's deceased parent, spouse,
11 sibling, child, or stepchild, provided the absence does not exceed 220 cumulative days;

12 (9) serving as a member of the United States Congress;

13 (10) serving on the staff of a member from this state of the United
14 States Congress;

15 (11) serving as an employee of the state in a field office or other
16 location;

17 (12) accompanying a minor who is absent under (5) of this subsection;

18 (13) accompanying another eligible resident who is absent for a reason
19 permitted under (1), (2), (5) - (12), (16), or (17) of this subsection as the spouse, minor
20 dependent, or disabled dependent of the eligible resident;

21 (14) serving as a volunteer in the federal peace corps program;

22 (15) because of training or competing as a member of the United States
23 Olympic Team or a United States national team for an Olympic sport;

24 (16) participating for educational purposes in a student fellowship
25 sponsored by the United States Department of Education or by the United States
26 Department of State;

27 (17) for any reason consistent with the individual's intent to remain a
28 state resident, provided the absence or cumulative absences do not exceed

29 (A) 180 days in addition to any absence or cumulative absences
30 claimed under (3) of this subsection if the individual is not claiming an absence
31 under (1), (2), or (4) - (16) of this subsection;

1 (B) 120 days in addition to any absence or cumulative absences
2 claimed under (1) - (3) of this subsection if the individual is not claiming an
3 absence under (4) - (16) of this subsection but is claiming an absence under (1)
4 or (2) of this subsection; or

5 (C) 45 days in addition to any absence or cumulative absences
6 claimed under (1) - (16) of this subsection if the individual is claiming an
7 absence under (4) - (16) of this subsection.

8 * **Sec. 3.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
9 read:

10 APPLICABILITY. AS 43.23.005(a), as amended by sec. 1 of this Act, applies to the
11 permanent fund dividend 2023 qualifying year for the 2024 dividend year and thereafter.

12 * **Sec. 4.** This Act takes effect January 1, 2023.
